All athletes who intend to participate in the ISSF World Cup must have an ISSF ID number. A maximum number of 3 shooters per event will be entered into the World Cup scoring. Two additional shooters per event may shoot for MQS, and will be listed separately according to their results, but without any ranking. The results of an MQS shooter can not be recognized as world records.

This World Cup will provide athletes the opportunity to achieve a Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) for the 2012 Olympic Games. Olympic quota places will not be awarded.

Please fill in the attached registration forms (ANNEX 1 - 9) and take care of the deadlines. All entries can be done by online-registration.

ISSF World Cup Munich as part of Olympic team trial

For those federations that want to use the Munich ISSF World Cup as part of their Olympic team trial the OC may offer the opportunity to squad three shooters from the same nation in the same relay. Please send information to the OC in time, in order to arrange this. The Technical Delegate has agreed to this handling.

ENTRY PROCESS

Preliminary Entries

Each national federation entering the ISSF World Cup must submit a preliminary entry (Annex 1) not later than **21 JAN 2012**.

If the ISSF online registration is used the preliminary entries will be entered there otherwise they must be send to the **ISSF Headquarters**.

Final Entries

The member federations make their final entries for athletes (Annex 3.1) and officials (Annex 3.3) directly to the **ISSF Headquarters** through online registration, fax or email. The deadline is fixed on **21 APR 2012**.

Late Entries

Late entries can only be allowed according to ISSF rule 3.7.3.4. Any additional entries received after the Final Entry deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day (17 MAY 2012) may not participate (ISSF rule 3.7.3.5)

Cancellation

Any federation reducing the number of shooters and / or officials after the Official Entry Deadline (21 APR 2012) is obligated to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid no member of that federation may participate. (ISSF rule 3.7.4.3).

ENTRY FEE

- € 170,- Euro per shooter / event
- € 50,- Euro per official
- € 50,- Euro for a late entry (additional / ISSF rule 3.7.3.4.3)

These fees include all charges for registration, airport shuttle, transport between shooting range and official hotels, doping control and practice during the event.

All payment has to be effected to the Organizing Committee.

Please transfer the money until **15 MAY 2012**.

Take care that all necessary data will be transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign the money to the right federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your head of delegation to take with them.

All payment has to be effected cash in EUR or traveler checks (**Euro only**) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival at the shooting range (no credit cards accepted).

Time frame: 22 MAY 2012, 7:30h till **12:00h at latest.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF rules. Detailed information is available on the ISSF homepage <u>www.issf-sports.org</u>.

The equipment control will be conducted to the ISSF rules using approved instruments including thickness stiffness devices.

All rifle shooters having an ISSF certificate are privileged at the equipment control section.

It is the shooter's responsibility that any air or Co² cylinder has been certified as safe and is still within the validity date. If the validity date has expired the use of the cylinder is not allowed.

Please note: Only a change from MQS to World Cup Ranking (Quota) is possible. The withdrawn (quota place) World Cup Ranking shooter may not shoot for MQS (ISSF rule 3.7.3.7).

SHOOTING RANGE

The ISSF World Cup will take place on the Olympic Shooting Range in Garching-Hochbrück / Munich.

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

- 10m hall 100 firing points, electronic targets, **Polytronic**
- 50m range 100 firing points, electronic targets, Polytronic
- 25m range 40 firing points (8 boxes), electronic targets, SIUS
- Final hall 20 firing points / For Rifle/Pistol, electronic targets, SIUS

The firing direction is north.

VISA

All nations who will need an official invitation of the German Shooting Sport Federation are requested to order these in time (Annex 5). Please take care yourself about all necessary information like special time limit or paragraphs.

Unless the Organizing Committee gets no special information, the invitation will be send out by fax and/or e-mail. If an express service should be desired, this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival. The German Shooting Sport Federation has no influence on the embassies!

The German Shooting Sport Federation can provide invitation for the period of the Munich WC only.

GUN LICENSE

You do **not** have to declare **air guns** and the proper ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard. Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they need to have the international embossing / stamping "F".



Owners of an **European firearms passport** may even import their small bore rifles and pistols **without** an auxiliary permission to Germany.

All nations who do **not** belong to the **European Union** have to use the provided online registration to **register their small bore** rifles and pistols as well as the proper ammunition.

After online registration of your guns you will receive a **general permission** from the district of Munich. This exceptional rule is valid from 20 to 29 MAY 2012.

Please make sure, that all delegation leaders and shooters arriving alone will carry the general permission as well as the list of all online registered firearms and ammunition to be presented to the customs.

The charge for an approved arms and ammunition declaration is \in 20,- per federation. This fee has to be paid together with the entry fees to the Organizing Committee.

Federations **arriving before 20 MAY or departing after 29 MAY** need a special permission – please contact the Organizing Committee in time.

Important: No weapons and ammunition transport is allowed by railway or other public transport facilities!

ARMS STORAGE / AMMUNITION

It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the shooting range especially not to the hotel. This German act also has to be followed strictly by nations, that are in the possession of an European firearms passport!! The completeness will be checked every evening. The armoury will be opened from 20 to 29 MAY 2012.

For arrival please note:

Upon your arrival in Germany (Munich), all arms and ammunition have to be transported to the Olympic Shooting Range **on a direct way**. All federations entering Germany with the general permission, have to store their arms and ammunition on the Olympic Shooting Range **only**. There is no possibility to have "pre competition training" on other facilities.

<u>For departure</u>: All arms and ammunition have to be removed from the armoury to the airport **on a direct way**. Even owners of an European firearms passport have to pick up their arms and ammunition on the armoury at time of departure, not earlier. Please keep in mind, that in Germany even owner of an European firearms passport are not allowed to leave their arms and ammunition unattended.

Additional ammunition can be purchased at the range. Please order the needed ammunition in advance stating the quantity and brand.

ASSISTANCE UPON ARRIVAL

The official pick up service starts at the first official arrival day 21 MAY. Delegations that arrive earlier or leave after the official departure day **have to make their own arrangements**.

Terminal 1

The person in charge will meet you between hall B and C (near the café and information desk) - carrying a sheet with the World Cup logo.

Terminal 2

You will be welcomed directly at the exit of your gate.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

Transportation from/to the Munich airport or main-station to the official hotels will be offered during the whole competition and includes a stop at the shooting range in order to store the weapons there. The delegations have to inform the **travel agency** about their arrival and departure details in time. Distances in Munich:

IMPORTANT!!



Due to some dangerous incidents in 2011, we have to remind all federations, that by German law it is strictly forbidden to cook or light a fire in the hotel rooms.

Please note, that due to two trade fairs (22 – 24 MAY) and the UEFA Champions League-Final (19 MAY) in Munich, the **hotel situation will be very sensible. So please be aware, that goodwill regulations for "no shows" or later arrivals/earlier departures will NOT be possible!!!**

Also do not send hotel reservations late, as we cannot guarantee for rooms after the deadline.

Preliminary Hotel Reservation must be effected by 21 JAN 2012.

Final Hotel Reservations must be effected by 20 MAR 2012!

Hotels will be booked in sequence of the receipt of the reservations at the travel agency.

The travel agency "hk travel plus GmbH" will send a confirmation to each delegation with name and address of the hotel you will stay at.

Reservations can only be considered once a deposit of 80% has been received by the travel agency by 05 APR 2012!

Payment within the stated deadline is absolutely evident otherwise we cannot guarantee accommodation in the official hotels! Bank details you will also find on the final hotel reservation form.

In case of cancellation after **05 APR 2012** and/or no-show the travel agency will charge a cancellation fee of 100% to the costs for all nights and rooms you have booked.

Your receipt for payment (only for accommodation) must be presented to the travel agency upon arrival in Munich. For any changes in reservation please contact the travel agency hk travel plus.

DOPING INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee will conduct doping controls according to the ISSF doping regulations.

CEREMONIES

The ceremonies will take place directly after the finals in the final hall. The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations. There is no opening or closing ceremony.

During the award or other ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms). All team members should be dressed in the same way, according to the ISSF-Dress-Code.

WEATHER INFORMATION

You may rest assured with minimum temperature of 18° per day and not less than 8° in the night. According to the weather information May is considered as one of the best month to visit Munich.

MEDIA RELATIONS
