All athletes who intend to participate in the ISSF World Cup must have an ISSF ID number. A maximum number of 3 shooters per event will be entered into the World Cup scoring. Two additional shooters per event may shoot for MQS, and will be listed separately according to their results, but without any ranking. The results of an MQS shooter can not be recognized as world records.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF rules. Detailed information is available on the ISSF homepage www.issf-sports.org.

The equipment control will be conducted to the ISSF rules using approved instruments including thickness stiffness devices.

All rifle shooters having an ISSF certificate are privileged at the equipment control section.

It is the shooter's responsibility that any air or Co2 cylinder has been certified as safe and is still within the validity date. If the validity date has expired the use of the cylinder is not allowed.

Please note: Only a change from MQS to World Cup Ranking (Quota) is possible. The withdrawn (quota place) World Cup Ranking shooter may not shoot for MQS (ISSF rule 3.7.3.7).

Late Entries

Late entries can only be allowed according to ISSF rule 3.7.3.4.

Any additional entries received after the deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day may not participate (ISSF rule 3.7.3.5)

Cancellation

Any federation reducing the number of shooters and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline is obligated to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid no member of that federation may participate. (ISSF rule 3.7.4.3).

ENTRY PROCESS

Preliminary Entries

Each national federation entering the ISSF World Cup must submit a preliminary entry (Annex 1) not later than **January 12th, 2009**.

If the ISSF online registration is used the preliminary entries will be entered there otherwise they must be send to the Organizing Committee.

Final Entries

The member federations make their final entries (Annex 4.1) directly to the **ISSF Headquarter** through online registration, fax or email.

The deadline is fixed on **April 12th, 2009**.

SHOOTING RANGE

The ISSF World Cup will take place on the Olympic Shooting Range in Garching-Hochbrück / Munich.

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

- 10m hall 100 firing points, electronic targets, **Polytronic**
- 50m range 100 firing points, electronic targets, **Polytronic**
- 25m range 40 firing points (8 boxes), electronic targets, **SIUS**
- Final hall 20 firing points / For Rifle/Pistol, electronic targets, **SIUS**
- There are five combined ranges for Trap, Skeet and Double Trap which are equipped with **Matarelli** machines.
- Clay Targets: Will be decided until March 2009. All ISSF member federations who sent a preliminary entry will be informed

VISA

All nations who will need an official invitation of the German Shooting Federation are requested to order these in time. Please inform yourself about all necessary information like special time limit or paragraphs.

As long as the Organizing Committee gets no special information, the invitation will be send out by fax and/or e-mail.

If an express service should be desired, this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival. **The German Shooting Federation has no influence on the embassies!**

ATTENTION

Due to problems in the past the German Shooting Federation can provide invitation for the period of the Munich World Cup **only**. **The visa support for the ISSF World Cup in Milan has to be enquired from the Italian Organizing Committee.**

GUN LICENSE

Owners of an European firearms passport may import their weapons without an auxiliary permission to Germany. *You don't have to declare air guns and the proper ammunition at all, if they conform to the international standard.*

All nations who do not belong to the European Union have to fill in the attached arms and ammunition form for small bore rifle and pistol.

Please fill in the form completely and do not forget to sign, as well as the **stamp/seal** of your federation. Attached you find an example to make the handling more easy for you. Please do not change the form or use your own form!

!! Incomplete forms can not be arranged and will be send back!!

The charge for an approved arms and ammunition declaration is 20,-€ per federation.

It is recommended to all delegations to carry a list of all firearms and ammunition with themselves, to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation. During your stay in Germany/Munich **all arms and ammunition** must be stored in the armory on the shooting range (also air weapons and ammunition).

CUSTOM FORMALITIES

All nations without the European firearms passport have to be in possession of the approved weapon importation form, certified by the German authorities. For those who arrive at the Munich airport, please make sure that you carry along a copy of your certified weapon form.

The **original documents** will be **deposited at the customs** where **you must pick them** up, before leaving the customs area.

Please note: To import air guns without an auxiliary permission, they need to have the international embossing / stamping "F".

ARMS STORAGE / AMMUNITION

It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the shooting range especially not to the hotel. The completeness will be checked every evening. The armory will be opened from the official arrival day till the official departure day, not earlier.

Additional ammunition can be purchased at the range. Please order the needed ammunition in advance stating the quantity and brand.

DOPING INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee will conduct doping controls according to the ISSF doping regulations.

CEREMONIES

The ceremonies will take place directly after the finals in the final hall. The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations. There is no opening or closing ceremony.

TRANSPORTATION / PICK UP

Transportation from/to the Munich airport or main-station to the official hotels will be offered during the whole competition and includes a stop at the shooting range in order to store the weapons there.
