GUN SAFETY:

•No guns are permitted in the hotels.

• All guns must be locked during the night in the storage room.

•On the whole range guns may only transported in a case or a box (R&P)

•Clean guns only in the Dry Fire area (10m Range), or in front of EQ Control

A large rifle-pistol athlete warm-up, dry fire area is located on the right-hand side of the 10m Range, ONLY

No equipment bags or gun boxes or cases are allowed on the firing line

Please ask the CRO for advice or assistance regarding where to place these bags and boxes

Removal and replacement may only take place at the range by command, and SAFETY FLAGS, (Rifle/Pistol).





Definition of Load:



ISSF JUNIOR WORLD CUP RIFLE / PISTOL / SHOTGUN SUHL, GER 09 MAY - 20 MAY 2022

A gun is considered loaded when a cartridge or pellet or a magazine with cartridges contacts a gun. No one may place a cartridge or pellet or magazine with cartridges in or on a gun or its chamber or barrel until the command "**LOAD**" is given.

EST Targets

•All EST targets are checked by firing of 5 shots and plot out to compare the accuracy and correctness.

•Light according the ISSF rules

•Time limits according to ISSF Rules

•No equipment bags or gun boxes or cases are allowed on the firing line, there is place behind





EQUIPMENT CONTROL CONSULTATION SERVICE:

•Athletes are responsible for ensuring that all items of equipment and clothing used by them in the World Cup comply with the ISSF-rules. The Equipment Control Jury will provide an equipment control consultation service, every day.

Time limit on the measuring plate for the stiffness control to the clothing it will be allowed a setting.

The maximum time limit for the measurement procedure is one minute in Post Competition checks.

•To ensure compliance with ISSF-rules, the EQ Jury will conduct random checks during qualification and finals and any athlete found to be in violation of the rules he will be disqualified

•Kinesio or Medical Taping is not allowed

Underclothing and Taping will be controlled during post-competition checks

•Post Competition Check will be conducted in all events



- Post Competition tests will be conducted in all rifle and pistol events according to ISSF rules
- Ammunition tests for Shotgun events will be conducted during the competitions
- Kinesio or Medical Taping is not allowed (Rifle & Pistol)
- Underclothing and Taping will be controlled during postcompetition checks
- Shotgun Equipment controls may be done here in the main EQ station (not mandatory), but the Jury will be checking during competitions, and in addition some hours at the Range.
- There is also a possibility to do the control at the shotgun range

SHOOT-OFFS:

• Team leaders whose shooters are eligible for shoot-offs are kindly requested to be in close contact with the Competition Office at the end of the Qualification rounds. As per ISSF Rules, shoot-offs are being conducted to decide the ranking in the final in case of tied scores and in case of ties to enter a final.

FINALS:

• New BIB-numbers will be distributed for the Finals, as per ISSF-rules. All finalists are kindly requested to observe the reporting times (30 minutes) of the Cartridge Control and of the Finals, in all FINAL ONLY 1 Reporting TIME.

Finals: Presentation of Medalists

At end of Final, immediately after "Results are final":

- Time allowed for brief "celebration" for winners and their coaches.
- Jury will assemble presentation of gold/silver/bronze medalists in center of FOP for TV and photos.
- Athletes can keep guns with them (must have safety flags).
- After presentation of medalists, all coaches and other finalists can congratulate the medalists.
- Coaches are responsible for removing guns and equipment after the Final.



ISSF Dress Code

- **Dress Code:** Governs clothing worn by athletes, coaches and officials (ITOs and NTOs) on field of play.
- **Objective.** To provide a positive, sport-centered image for spectators and the media.
- Award Ceremonies. Athletes must be dressed in national uniforms (NOC uniforms in OG)
- **Prohibited Clothing**. Jeans, non-sporting colors, camouflage, shorts that are too short, sandals, etc.
- Changing Clothes. Not permitted on ranges; changing must be done in changing rooms.
- A Jury Member will check medal winners' clothing before Victory Ceremonies—can stop cer athlete is not dressed properly.
